

### Kindergarten and 1<sup>st</sup> graders

headphones  
box of sandwich size Ziploc bags  
change of clothes in plastic bag labeled with your child's name

2 boxes of hand wipes

### 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> graders

red pen for correcting and editing  
#2 pencils (2 dozen would be a great start)  
colored pencils and/or crayons (no markers)  
7 ½ x 9 ½ composition book-not a spiral  
Headphones

pointed scissors-Fiskars or similar  
glue stick (at least one)  
big pink eraser  
1 pee chee type folders

good quality zipper pouch-(these are used several times per day and the flimsy one don't last) **OR** pencil box (approximately 9 x 6)

### 4<sup>th</sup>, 5<sup>th</sup> and 6<sup>th</sup> graders

#### Necessary

pointed scissors-Fiskars or similar  
eraser  
Headphones  
Pen for correcting-not fluorescent gel pen  
1 inch 3 ring binder with inside pocket  
ruler-I like the clear ones (can be colored)  
good quality zipper pouch-(these are used several times per day and the flimsy one don't last)  
7 ½ x 9 ½ composition book-not a spiral

pencils  
notebook paper  
2 pee chee type folders  
2 **large** book covers-not the adhesive  
Large brown paper bags work great!  
colored pencils
