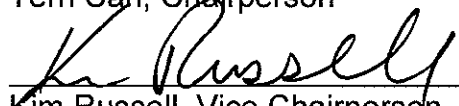
3. Enrollment for January is 58 FTE.

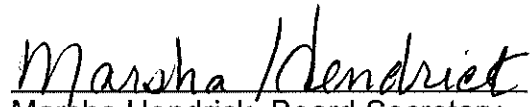
